ROOM WITH A VIEW

FIRE TOWER SUITE AT CLOUD CAMP AT **EROADMOOR**

Colorado Springs, CO

The best vistas require effort, and Cloud Camp, a 9,200-foot elevation wilderness experience from Colorado's historic Broadmoor hotel, is about as off the grid as it gets. Reaching the mountaintop hideaway requires a 3-hour hike, stomach-turning car ride, or retired Grand Canyon mule. For the ultimate view, you'll need to climb 145 more steps to this one-of-a-kind suite, built on the stone foundation of a former fire tower. Wake up in the clouds and take in 360° views of Pikes Peak from the telescope in a dedicated observation room. From \$1,400, all-inclusive; broad moor.com/cloud-camp
