




COST: Varies depending on the season and chosen treatments, but guests can expect to pay around \$1,100 per day.

LOCATION: SANMARCOS, CALIF.

A-LIST AMENITIES: When celebrities need to Zen out, they flock to this hidden gern, which got its name from the Asian-inspired glimmering gate that sits at the entrance of the property. With fresh produce grown on the resort's biointensive farms, meals are customized for each guest's dietary requirements and preferences. Visitors need not pack much more than a toothbrush since rooms are stocked with sweats, shorts, T-shirts and terry robes, as well as luxurious Golden Door Skin Care products that will pamper the skin and please the senses. UNIQUE TREATMENTS: The Door is known for its full-body, detoxifying herbal wraps using linen sheets steeped in a steaming bath infused with rosemary handpicked off the property. LOCATION: MALIBU, CALIF.

A-LIST AMENITIES: Located in the stunning Santa Monica Mountains, this results-oriented retreat is for people who are serious about recalibrating their lifestyles and achieving their health goals. The intensive seven-day stay includes daily workouts and spa treatments; a 1,400-calorie-a-day, plant-based meal plan; plus pre- and post-program cholesterol testing and body fat analysis. And it's seriously exclusive: Each session is limited to just 18 guests who must be prepared to unplug, as the resort has a strict no WiFi or cell phone policy. UNIQUE TREATMENTS: Besides their buzzed-about massages, the Ranch also offers whole-body cryotherapy, group hikes, fitness classes and a weekly cooking class with a tour of the on-site certified organic garden.

A-LIST AMENITIES: Overlooking the picturesque white sand shores of Miami Beach, this lavish resort features the largest spa in the region (70,000 square feet), an integrative medical wellness center, spacious one- and two-bedroom suites, more than 20 different daily fitness classes, a two-story indoor rock wall, four pools, three dining venues and Miami's only therapeutic igloo.

UNIQUE TREATMENTS: If being in vacation mode is what it takes to

reenergize your mind, body and soul, this is the place to go! Offerings include the Thermal Experience — one of the country's largest hydrotherapy circuits — featuring nine suites designed to stimulate circulation, relieve pain, decrease stress and rejuvenate the body. Mirroring European wellness traditions, the resort boasts separate men's and women's hot and cold areas where guests can warm, cleanse and relax prior to a spa treatment or following a workout. Aemotio Spa, an advanced-multifunction cabin decked out with a height-adjustable water bed, color therapy, aromatherapy steam bath, and Vichy shower), for nontraditional experiences including Turkish Rhassoul, Sleep Ritual treatments and Grotta Giusti mud body masks. COSTi Nightly rate starts at \$499 for a one-bedroom suite.
