



NEW LIFE HIKING SPA

hat New Life Hiking Spa doesn't

offer: Frette sheets, facials, or TRX suspension trainers. What it does: daily guided hikes in the Green Mountains of Vermont, communal meals, and an all-inclusive price tag of just \$250 a night. The 38-year-old spa has a very devoted following-roughly 46 percent of its guests are repeat visitors.

New Life devotees love the unpretentious vibe of the place. "It's kind of like adult camp," says Jimmy LeSage, who founded the spa in 1978. And just like camp, it's open only for part of the yearspecifically, May through October. The guest quarters are done in rustic Vermont style, with queen-size beds. "It's a nice room, not the Ritz," LeSage says. That's certainly no deterrent for boldfaced names-New Life draws actors, professional athletes, and CEOs, and has even hosted a Supreme Court justice.
